After the Bhoomi Poojan on 23rd May 1999, the construction started and Dev Sanskriti Mahavidyalaya came into existence. The college gained the status of 'Dev Sanskriti Vishwavidyalaya' on the basis of an act (22.01.2002) passed by state legislature and notified in the gazette vide notification no. (123/vidhayi & sansadiya karya/2002 dated 11-4-2002). The university is recognized by University Grant Commission, India under the 1956 act section 2(F) and also has been duly certified by ISO 9001:2015 on 27.01.2014 and accredited by NAAC with 'B' grade on 14.09.2015. The selection of the candidate will be done on the basis of entrance examination and research deliberation.

01. The entrance exam will consist of two papers. The first will be over research techniques (methods), involving subjective questions will include yoga, psychology, statistics and research techniques. The second paper will consist of objective questions.
02. The syllabus for the written entrance exam will include the subjects of masters/PG courses and the syllabus set by UGC for NET examination.
03. The candidates qualifying the written entrance exam will have to go through research deliberation/discourse. The final selection will be done on the basis of both written examination as well as the research deliberation.
04. For the research discussion maximum 4 scholars may be called upon for first seator the scholars will be called upon on the basis of qualifying the written examination.
05. The students selected on the basis of written examination and research deliberation will be given admission on the basis of Merit list.
06. The reservation list set/given by the state government will be permissible.
07. The candidates who have qualified the NET & M. PHIL examination will be exempted from the written entrance exam but research deliberation is mandatory for everyone.(the candidates must submit a copy of their certificates of NET & M.phil compulsorily with the admission form)
08. The candidates who have qualified the M.phil examination and will be selected in the entrance exam will also be exempted from course work. To get exemption from coursework the certificates of M.PHIL needs to be submitted positively.

- Scanned Copy of the Passport
- Passport size photographs (recent)
- Letter of recommendation from 2 referees
- English Language Proficiency Certificate

Process after Application Form is Received

- When complete application form is received, it is then processed and the candidate will be sent a letter of acknowledgement with an application number. Students will also be intimated if any additional information is required to ensure their eligibility for the applied course program. Some applicants may be asked to appear for an in-person (if in India) or online interview in front of Pro Vice Chancellor or a nominated member by him before the admission is offered to the candidate.
- Once the eligibility is ensured, the admission pack with all the necessary information will be sent to the candidate. After receiving the admission pack, student shall proceed to the Indian Embassy in their native country to obtain the student VISA. Once the student visa is obtained, they shall immediately contact on international@dsvv.ac.in to notify the authorities with their date, time and mode of arrival to the University.
- Students are advised to reach the University Campus 1-2 days prior to the commencement of classes and report to the Office of Pro Vice Chancellor. They would then be asked to submit their official or original documents as listed in the admission letter. They shall also need to take a test of English proficiency and submit a proof of medical fitness. Thereafter candidates will be issued an 'Admission Order'. Only after the admission formalities are completed students will be permitted to move into the allotted hostels.
- It is mandatory that all foreign students holding foreign citizenship have to register with the Foreigner's Registration Office (FRO) within the stipulated time frame of their arrival in India. A student who is a PIO/OCI Card holder is also required to register with the FRO. Dev Sanskriti Vishwavidyalaya will provide the necessary assistance in this regard.

Admission Process - 5 steps

SCAN to Apply



1. Application

- **Online:** Applicants can fill and submit the form online on <http://www.dsvv.ac.in>. They will have to upload the scanned copies of relevant attested mark sheets, documents and passport size photograph along with signature.
- Payment ` 1200/- (excluding payment gateway charges) can be done by one of the following ways: net banking / debit card / credit card / UPI / Wallet.
- Applications received after the due date or with incomplete information shall not be accepted.
- Request for change in Program applied and written entrance exam center may be done before the last date of application form submission.
- Correction in the online form will attract a fee of ` 200/-. Final decision on the change will be taken by The Registrar, DSVV & shall be considered final.
- The university holds the right to cancel any application form at any stage without any prior notice to the candidate.
- Any dispute for the Application can be challenged before the Vice Chancellor of Dev Sanskriti Vishwavidyalaya (DSVV) and his decision will be final.
- Admission fees once paid will not be refunded.
- Each candidate is allowed to apply for only one program, with the exception of the B.Ed program.
- Candidates are permitted to apply for only one program, with the exception of the B.Ed. Program. In the event that a candidate applies for the B.Ed. Program and is selected for both the B.Ed. Program and another program, the candidate will be required to choose one program to pursue.

2. Written Entrance Examination

- The written examination will be conducted, at the declared date, at the exam center allocated which will be mentioned in the admit card.

3. Interview

- Interview round will be conducted at Dev Sanskriti Vishwavidyalaya, Haridwar for candidates who are selected in the written entrance examination. Applicants are required to bring all their documents for verification in original.

4. Medical Fitness Certificate

- Applicants who are shortlisted in interview round will have to bring a medical fitness certificate (format available at university website) duly signed by registered medical practitioner at the time of admission.

5. Final Admission Process

- Submission of the required documents along with the maintenance fee of the first semester. The payment of maintenance fee can be made through **Online** mode by university website.
- Reservation in seats will be applicable as per the rules of Uttarakhand government.
